THE BEGINNING HISTORY OF BANCROFT: as told by Peg Dailey:
Bancroft was a small town that sprang up after the Civil War and the
government didn't have the money to pay the fighting men ,so they paid
off by giving them so many acres of unsettled land. They called Bancroft
Entergetic then and the coal mine family's bought and also built two rows
of small four room houses. One row for negroes and one row for whites.
The mines began opening on both sides of the owners and they sold some
of the land to coal companies. The Hatfield Camels Creek Coal Company
bought some of the land and built houses on part of it. Bancroft then at
that time had several business places.

A large saloon, a grocery store, a Barber Shop, a Post office, a bullet shop, a show building, a shoe repair shop, a broom factory, a garage and tool sharpening building. Boy, it boomed fast!
