

**MEETING MINUTES  
TOWN OF BANCROFT  
NOVEMBER 19, 2020**

Mayor Donna McKneely called the meeting held at the Bancroft Volunteer Fire Department to order at 7:00 pm. Council members present: Wally Harper, Bethany Adkins and Marie Dailey. Jami Hayes and Dave McClung via ZOOM.

Councilwoman Adkins moved to accept the minutes as presented. Councilman Harper then moved to approve the financial statement and further moved to pay the invoices (all motions passed).

Town Ordinances – council discussed how best to update the ordinances. There are fifteen total sections, and we may be able to take a section at a time. Also need to add in by-laws.

Council discussed the First Annual Bancroft Thanksgiving Parade. The Sheriff is going to lend an officer to lead the parade, and they will post it on FaceBook. It starts at 10am, and will line up across from the Catholic Church and make a circle up to the park and back again.

Streets & Highways: a resident has suggested cutting the ends of the speed bumps off for strollers. Council discussed this and is not in agreement since everyone would drive around them into people's yards. Council still needs to work on removing the speed bumps from the main drag for fire trucks going in/out of the bottom.

Council then discussed ideas for a new grant that paperwork is due on soon. Councilwoman Hayes has the paperwork, and needs to present a proposal at the next County Commission meeting, so she needs to nail down the projects and dollars in order to apply for the grant.

Website and FaceBook going smoothly, and the Website administrator was able to help with a technical issue.

Council discussed a Holiday Decoration and Light Contest in town. Councilwoman Adkins will make announcement on FaceBook and the council will decide at their December meeting and announce winners in the newsletter and on FaceBook.
