MEETING MINUTES TOWN OF BANCROFT DECEMBER 17, 2020

Commissioner Skidmore noted that he sees people at the Bancroft Park all the time! Project completion will be 12/31/21 and max amount is \$21,500 with a match of \$4,300 from the town. Council then discussed bids and drawing up a contract for the work and timeframe to be completed in. Recorder reminded the council to remember this during March budget session.

The park bathrooms have been winterized. Councilman Harper has been working on streetlight reconciliation, since there are three lights we are being charged for that they couldn't find. Ms. Watson, our account representative, will go back 6 months and issue a credit for those lights.

Councilman Harper said that Fire Department will be doing a Christmas parade thing for Hometown Elementary on Tuesday, 12/22 starting at 1pm. They will follow the bus route and Santa will be present!

Mayor McKneely noted that we have several bags of salt available, which will be at the Post Office and by the park bathroom area.
