Bancroft Volunteer Fire Department

1 Oct started fire season. There is no burning from 7am – 5pm daily until 1 Jan 2024, which will end at that time. The fire dept responded to several bush fires last past spring and we ask that you please observe. We have attached a flyer on the burn laws.

Fire Prevention week is 8-14 Oct 2023.

This year's theme for fire prevention is "Cooking safety starts with YOU"

According to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) the leading cause of home fires with nearly half (49%) of all home fires involve cooking equipment. Below are some recommendations to help reduce accidents:

Always keep a close eye on what you're cooking. For foods with longer cook times, such as those that are simmering or baking, set a timer to help monitor them.

Clear the cooking area of combustible items and keep anything that can burn, such as dish towels, oven mitts, paper towels, etc

Turn pot handles toward the back of the stove. Keep a lid nearby when cooking. If a small grease fire starts, slide the lid over the pan and turn off the burner.

Create a "Kid and pet free zone" of at least three feet (one meter) around the cooking area and anywhere else hot food or drink is prepared or carried.
