

**MEETING MINUTES
TOWN OF BANCROFT
DECEMBER 19, 2019**

Mayor Donna McKneely called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer, Pledge of Allegiance and State Pledge. All were present during roll call: David McClung, Bethany Adkins, Jami Hayes, Wally Harper, Thomas Frame, Marie Dailey and Donna McKneely.

After council read over the minutes; Councilman Harper moved to accept the minutes as presented (motion passed). Councilman McClung then moved to approve the financial statement and Councilman Harper moved to pay the invoices (both motions passed). It was discussed and decided to pay Ed Higginbotham at month end, as he only had 2 hours so far, and some work was scheduled for him.

Mayor McKneely stated that the post office repairs will start after the contractor's current job is complete. He hopes to be here and complete work within the next month.

Council then discussed the park grant, and it was decided to go with a black metal roof as a replacement on the current gazebo. We have until end of June to gather associated costs and submit for reimbursement.

Council discussed the need to redo the ordinances, and this was tabled for January.

Mayor McKneely then passed around a photo of a veteran's memorial that she thinks would look good at the park.

STREETS: Someone ran over the sign at North River Lane and destroyed Nancy Booth's paper box. The blue sign is intact, but we need another pole to reinstall the sign.

PARKS: One fence post (chain link fence) is broken and will need repaired. Santa at the Park (in the gazebo) will take place on Friday Dec 20 from 6-8, and council members donating items were reminded to have everything up there.

With no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
