

**MEETING MINUTES
TOWN OF BANCROFT
NOVEMBER 21, 2019**

Mayor Donna McKneely called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer, Pledge of Allegiance and State Pledge. Roll call: David McClung, Bethany Adkins, Jami Hayes, Wally Harper, Thomas Frame and Marie Dailey present.

After council read over the minutes; Councilman McClung moved to accept the minutes as presented (motion passed). Councilwoman Adkins then moved to approve the financial statement and Councilwoman Hayes moved to pay the invoices (both motions passed).

Mayor then brought up the badly needed post office repairs. We received a couple of bids, but the short work time frame (limited to post office hours only) makes it hard for people to perform needed work. Burdette Realty submitted a bid of \$12,000 and Legg, LLC submitted a bid for \$4425. After some discussion, Councilman Harper moved to have Legg, LLC repair the post office per their bid of \$4425; Councilwoman Hayes seconded and motion passed. Mayor McKneely to advise Legg, LLC to begin work.

Council then discussed cameras at the park. Talked about WIFI at the park (currently do NOT have) and what type of recordings we would be able to see – and who would be monitoring. Matter was tabled to a later date. Councilman Harper took the tennis nets down today.

Mayor McKneely then discussed the Veteran's Memorial – discussed a plaque or some type of memorial listing all the servicemen who served from Bancroft. Project still in the works.

Council talked about Santa in the Park, and it is scheduled for Friday, December 19 from 6-8pm. Mayor McKneely will donate the cost of Santa; Recorder Marie Dailey will donate hot chocolate and candy canes to pass out and Councilman McClung will donate cookies. Mayor McKneely stated Mr. and Mrs. Claus will be there.

Council discussed need to clean leaves away from the storm sewers. Councilman Harper has been reporting the broken streetlights. Councilwoman Adkins reports all going well with the Website and Facebook announcements have been phenomenal!

With no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
